

# CPR XI

## Entry Form

(1 entry form per boat/crew)

**Event Description:** A rigorous two-day, 115-mile endurance row on a free-flowing river with unmarked and unknown obstacles and hazards, to be held May 29 – May 31, 2009 (inspections, instructions, and introductions on May 29.)

**Entry Fee:** Entry fee of \$150 per participant (coxswains included) is due with entry. \$175 after May 15, 2009. Entry fee includes Friday dinner, rest stops and dinner on Saturday, breakfast and lunch on Sunday, Saturday night campsite, commemorative t-shirt, and way-cool medal by Bill Byrd (if you finish). Entry fees are nonrefundable after April 15, 2009, and checks should be payable to **New World Rowing**.

**Eligibility:** All participants must be experienced rowers in superb physical condition with active USRA memberships, including coxswains. All entries are subject to Committee approval.

**Deadline:** No entries will be considered if postmarked after May 20, 2009. Entry into CPR XI is limited to 20 boats/crews, and 50 individuals, and qualifying entries will be accepted in the order received.

**CPR XI**  
**Corvallis Portland Row 2009**  
**Waiver and Certification**

IN CONSIDERATION of being given the opportunity to participate in the Corvallis Portland Row held on May 29 – May 31, 2009 (“CPR XI”), I, for myself, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin:

ACKNOWLEDGE, AGREE AND REPRESENT that (a) I understand the physical and mental demands of participating in a rowing event covering over 100 miles and lasting two (2) days; (b) I am in physical and mental condition to be able to withstand the rigors of participation in such an event, including but not limited to, blisters, boils, sores, sunstroke, dehydration, hyperthermia, hypothermia, over-use injuries, sudden, unexpected immersion in water, harassment by nonparticipants in motorboats, jetskis, floatplanes, canoes and kayaks, and collision with obstacles both fixed and floating; and (c) I am a capable swimmer, able to survive for 30 minutes in 65 degree Fahrenheit water.

ACKNOWLEDGE, agree and represent that I FULLY UNDERSTAND that: (a.); ROWING ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death (“Risks”); (b.) these Risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in CPR XI, the condition in which CPR XI takes place, or the negligence of the Releases named below; (c.); there may be other risks and social and economic losses either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I incur as a result of my participation in CPR XI.

AGREE AND WARRANT that I will examine and inspect CPR XI and if I observe any condition which I consider to be unacceptably hazardous or dangerous, I will notify the proper authority in charge of CPR XI AND I WILL REFUSE TO TAKE PART IN CPR XI until the condition has been corrected to my satisfaction.

HEREBY RELEASE, discharge, and covenant not to sue USRowing, New World Rowing, Oregon State University, Willamette Rowing Club, Oregon Rowing Unlimited, their administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers and employees, other participating regatta organizers, any sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises, on which CPR XI takes place, (each considered one of the “Releasees” herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations; and I further agree that if, despite this release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement, I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releasees, I WILL INDEMNIFY, SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS each of the Releasees, from any litigation’s expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage, or cost which any may incur as a result of such claim.

**I have read this agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it and have signed it freely and without any inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid, the balance, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect.**
